But, for those who are able and desire to worship here, we are ensuring that it can be done in a safe manner that meets and exceeds the necessary guidelines from the department of health and our local government leaders. 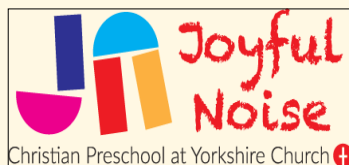
