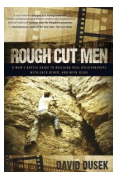
For Men

to participate in a Series called "**Rough Cut Men**"

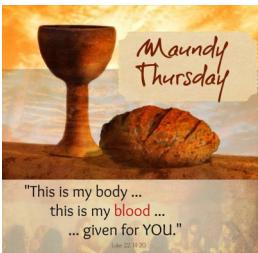
