

#### **The Mission of Jesus**



**Pack 25's opening "Scout Day" event will be held September 11<sup>th</sup> at Rocky Ridge Park Grey Squirrel Pavilion from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM. "Scout Day" offers prospective Scouts to try out a variety of scouting activities and meet other youth already in the Scouting Program.**

Scouts is assigned to a den (at their grade level) for the school year. Dens generally have 3-4 weeknight meetings per month. We also have one Pack-wide meeting a month.
