

Dear Dave and Congregation,

"And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Mt. 28:18-20). Here lies the mission that Jesus has left with us, his people. To make disciples of all nation! Our God is a global God who desires people from every nation, tribe, people, and language to know him (Rev. 7:9). My heart was stirred again to the reality of how much work is to be done in the world for the sake of the gospel

The country that my team and I just returned from has somewhere between a .1-.3% of a Christian population. There are over 80 million people in this country who do not know Jesus Christ and have likely never heard the gospel. They may know the name of Jesus but have not heard the good news of a loving God who has sent his Son to save them from their sins through his death and resurrection. Many of them have never met a Christian in their lives. Would you stop here and sit in the weight of this? Would you pray for laborers to go out into the harvest and proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ?



It was a joy and a honor to be able to be a part of this trip! We spent time exploring the city, understanding the culture, as well as being able to meet several students. My favorite day consisted of a teammate and I being able to spend 4 hours with two students at a local university. It was a great time getting to know them as well as being able to dive in to spiritual conversation. They know that we are followers of Christ and I pray that this would be a seed that God would use in their lives to draw them to himself and into a relationship with Jesus.

Finally, I want to invite you to pray with me as I am considering and discerning if God would have me serve in this country for the next year. A part of this trip was to get a taste of what living and doing ministry there would look like. The need is great for there to be ambassadors of Christ sent to this place! I would feel honored to be called there to be a light for the gospel. 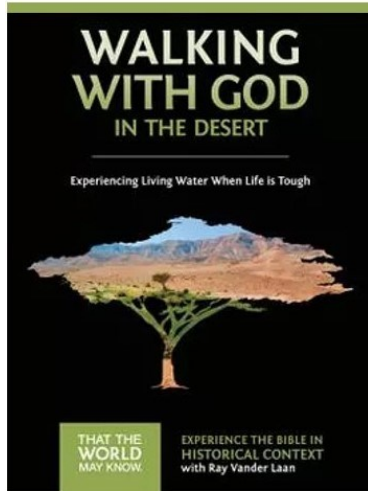

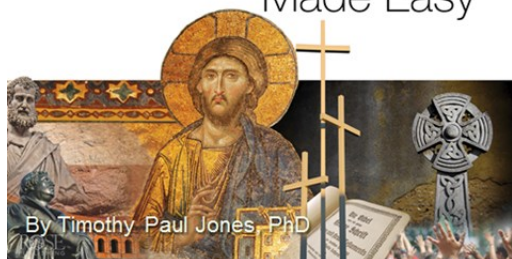

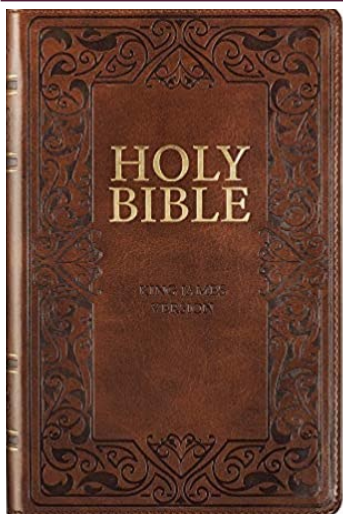
Christian History Made Easy
