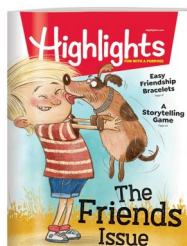

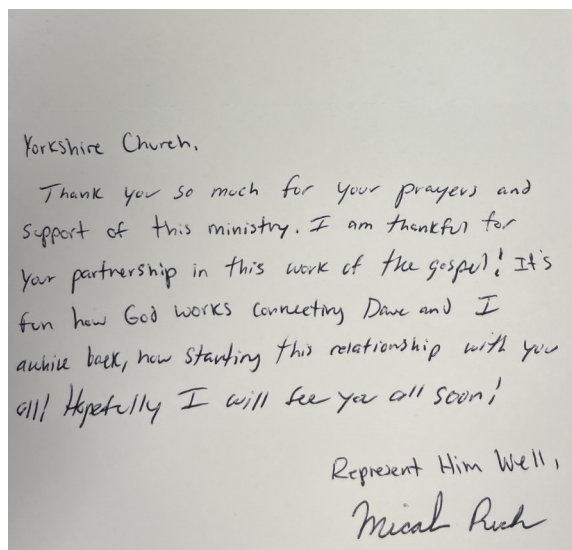
## Youth Ministry

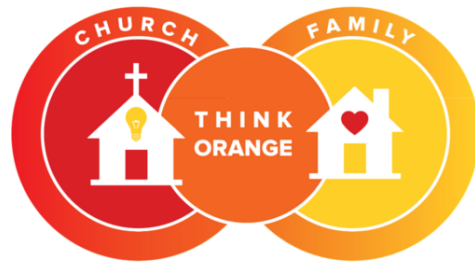

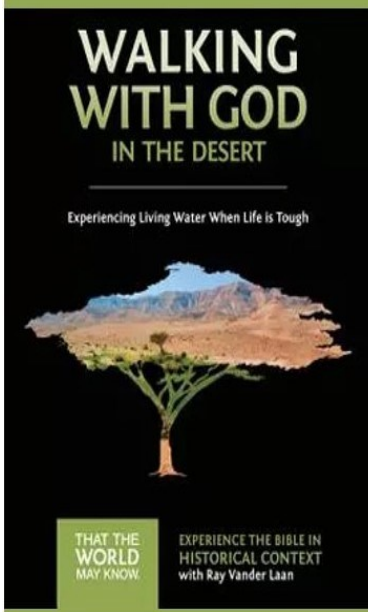

## SANCTUARY VIDEO STUDY: WALKING WITH GOD IN THE DESERT



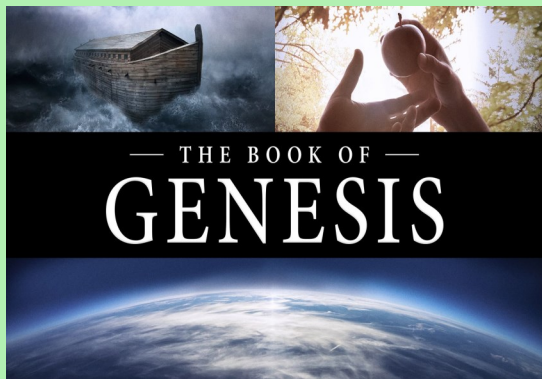

## ROOM 202: Dale Achenbach and Steve Coates

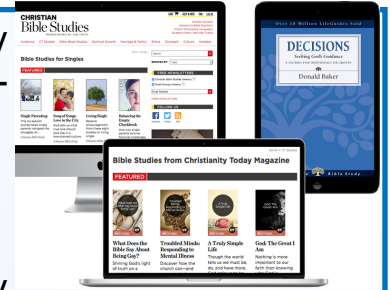
Class session will feature interactive discussions of weekly podcasts created by the editors of Christianity Today magazine.

## Bible Study

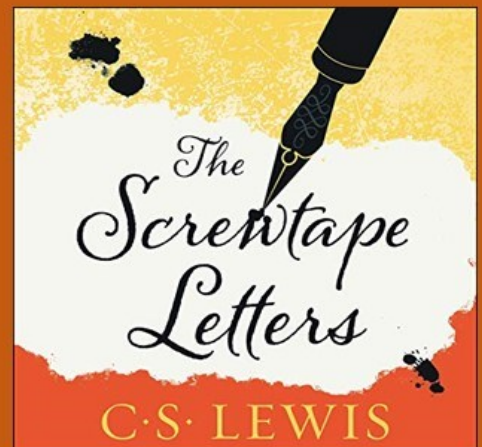
Men's Fellowship Summer Series
