## Who Wants to Go For A CLIMB?




Our new **CLIMB** program kicked off on August 7th, but we would love to encourage more children participate in this new and exciting adventure.

# Children's Classes







# SANCTUARY VIDEO STUDY: WALKING WITH GOD IN THE DESERT



The first class will provide the attendees an opportunity to review such lists on-line and choose and prioritize topics for presentation and discussion in upcoming weeks.


Each weekly class session will then feature an on-line presentation of the selected podcast with time allowed either interactively or summarily for discussion among class attendees.
