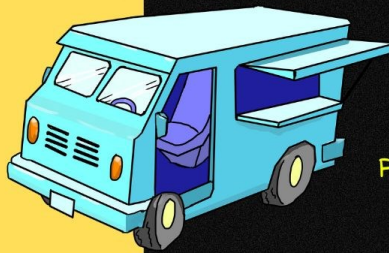
Ladies of Yorkshire Church!

Our new **CLIMB** program kicked off on August 7th, but we would love to encourage more children participate in this new and exciting adventure.

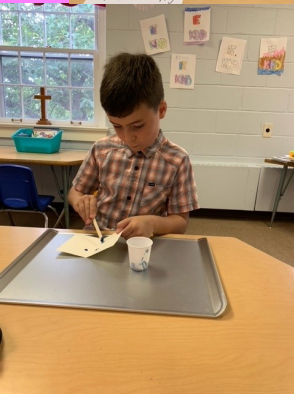
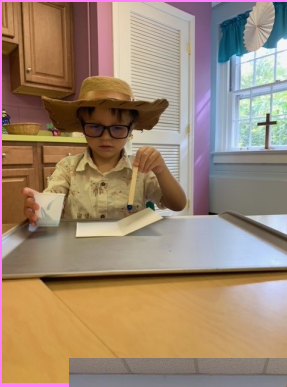

SANCTUARY VIDEO STUDY: WALKING WITH GOD IN THE DESERT



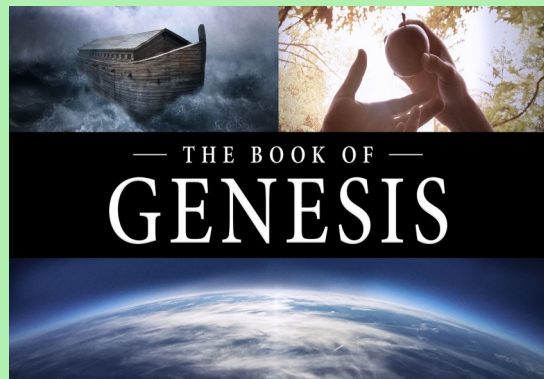

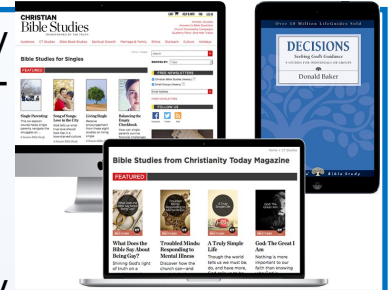
Class session will feature interactive discussions of weekly podcasts created by the editors of Christianity Today magazine.

Bible Study

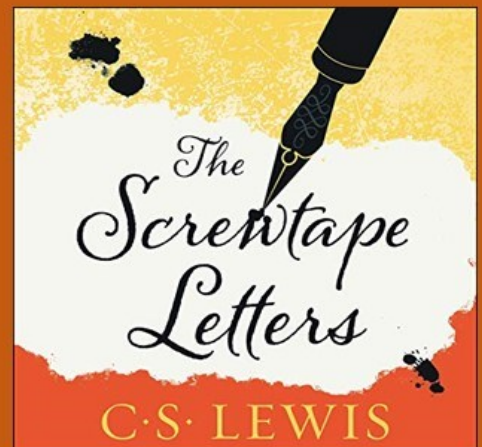
Men's Fellowship Summer Series

The primary focus will be to look at scriptural references to our video topic as well as from the book.



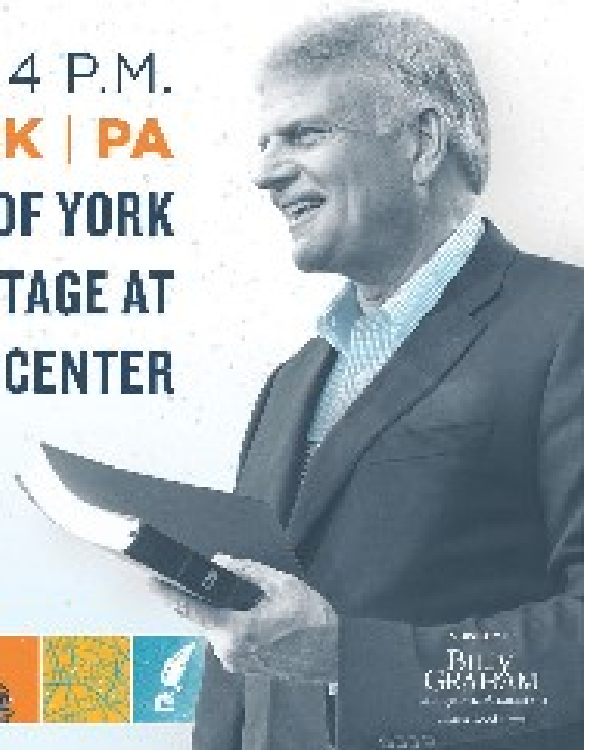
