

Dear Yorkshire Fellowship,

Thank you for the many inquiries that we have received from you regarding how to support the Joyful Noise Christian Preschool!

As a preschool, our goal is to provide the best possible experience for our children which includes small class sizes, highly qualified teachers, Christian education and maintaining an affordable tuition for our families.

As most of you are aware, JNCP is a mission of Yorkshire Church which means that we use Missions funds to offset our Preschool expenses. The Preschool is our largest mission expense, and this year, due to rising costs and a slightly lower enrollment rate, we are running at a deficit. The church has provided graciously for our supply needs from our Giving Heart Tree and now lobby Mission Board. As we continue to have needed supplies, we will put them up on the Mission Board in the church lobby.

There are several ways to give to the Preschool. One way is to put money in the collection plate labeled "Preschool" or "JNCP" and the other way is to give online under the "Preschool" tab. The "Preschool *Tuition*" tab is for Preschool Families to pay their student's tuition expenses.

You can also support our preschool by letting people know about us in your day-to-day conversations as you are out and about. I know this is happening because we have received referrals from some congregation members--but the more the merrier! We teach our students about the Bible and that Jesus loves them. We show them love every day and we teach them to love one another. We have a great team and great families and we know that JNCP fills a great need in our community.
