The project took a total of 708 hours to complete. Austin could not have completed this project without the help of his fellow scouts, Troop leaders (current and past), church members, family and friends. Starting as a Tiger Cub, Austin has been a Scout for 10 years. Since crossing over to the Troop, he has earned 27 merit badges and served as Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader and Librarian. He is also a member of Scouts BSA's Order of the Arrow. Austin is currently a Junior at Central York High School and upon graduation, is interested in studying astrophysics at a undetermined university.

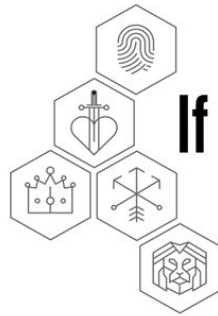

Class session will feature interactive discussions of weekly podcasts created by the editors of Christianity Today magazine.

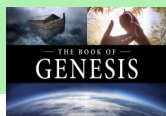

As we read through The Word, we'll be using guides and discussing what God is telling us from 2000+ years ago before He sent His Son. All are welcome, bring your Bible and join us.

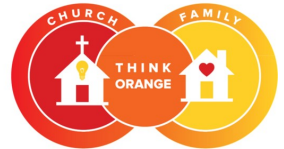

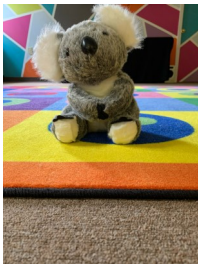

Children's Classes

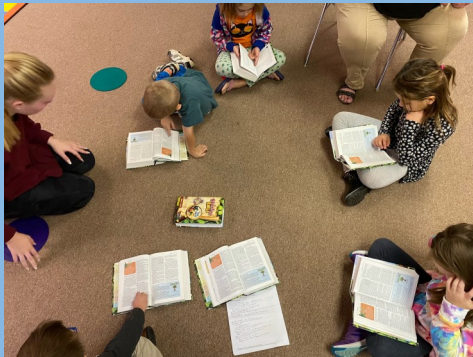
