Excerpts from “Most Teenagers Drop Out of Church When They Become Young Adults” by LifeWay Research:

“Two-thirds (66%) of American young adults who attended a Protestant church regularly for at least a year as a teenager say they also dropped out for at least a year between the ages of 18 and 22, according to a new study from Nashville-based LifeWay Research. 34% say they continued to attend twice a month or more”

“Those who stayed saw the church as an important part of their entire life. When asked why they stayed in church, more than half say the church was vital part of their relationship with God (56%) and that they wanted the church to help guide their decisions in everyday life.”

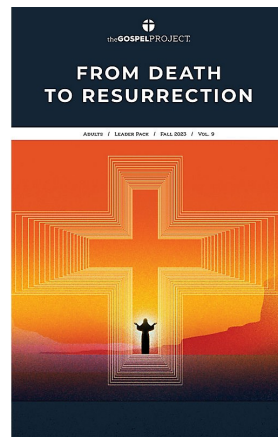
Both classes have application for today's world!

Rally Day 2023!

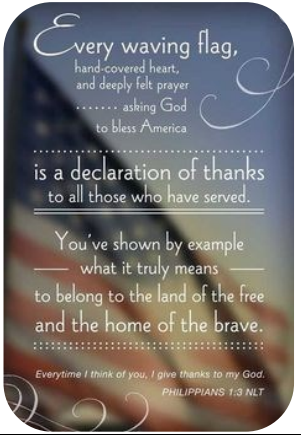
