


On April 29th reports were updated on the flooding in Kenya. Kim is safe, there are numerous needs. Pray for families in the area, missing individuals, families to be reunited, homes re-established, basic needs are met and many more.

'Media sources report that all 47 counties across Kenya are affected by flooding following heavy rainfall. The impacted counties include Kiambu, Narok, Tana River, Garissa, Lamu, Nairobi, Turkana, Busia, Marsabit, Homa Bay, Taita Taveta, Nakuru, and Kisumu. Updated media sources indicate that up to 185,000 people have been displaced due to the flooding. At least 50 people were killed and around 49 people are still remain missing in Nakuru County, near Mai Mahiu, due to a dam collapse in the River Tongi after heavy rainfall. At least six people were killed in Mathioya due to landslides following the heavy rainfall. Earlier sources reported that at least 103 people were killed, 29 people were injured, and at least 19 people remain missing. Nairobi County is reportedly the most impacted region, with 16,909 households being affected. In total, previous updates indicated that over 66,000 people have been displaced since March. This includes at least 30,000 people displaced in Nairobi, as well as 150 families in Simbi, Homa Bay County, and 600 families in Budalangi, Busia County. Hundreds of households in Kisumu and along the Tana River have also been displaced, while at least 100 households from Ngurubani in Mwea, Kirinyaga County, have been evacuated. Graceland Park residents are reportedly isolated by floodwaters. Up to 50 people were rescued from a submerged bus on the A3 highway in Madogo. In Homa Bay, at least four villages were submerged in Karachuonyo. An unspecified number of homes were also inundated across Machakos County. Multiple roadways and bridges were damaged or destroyed. Expect associated disruptions." Info from NC4, an independent global crisis reporting agency




