The Call to Prayer and Praise (*Responsively*)

Leader: "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have all turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

People: You revealed your law to Moses, O god, but your people set up a golden calf.

Leader: You challenged them, through your great prophets, to seek justice for the poor; but your people preferred false prophets who set their consciences at ease.

People: At last, O God, you sent your own Son to woo them back; but your people plugged up their ears and led him to the cross to be crucified.

Leader: We are your people, O God, all of us: Guilty, judged, seeking forgiveness.

People: Accept our plea for mercy,

All: For we offer it in the name of you Son, our crucified, merciful Lord. Amen.
